1. NHS 111 in-hours direct booking in NWL

Practices will have received a communication from Harrow CCG regarding a NWL project that would enable patients calling 111 to be seen in their own practice during opening hours, where clinically appropriate.

The CCG recognise that the setting aside of appointments for 111 re-direction is not a contractual requirement. The CCG has also confirmed that practice participation in this project is not linked to their eligibility to apply for any future enhanced services wraparound contract. The LMC will engage further with the CCG as this project develops.

Although 111 re-direction is not a current contractual requirement, practices may want to consider what practical steps need to be taken in preparation for any future obligations.

2. Updated Capita/PCSE claims guidance

Primary Care Support England (PCSE), also known as Capita, have been responsible for the delivery of NHS England's primary care support services since September 2015.

GPs and LMCs identified serious issues with the service from the outset, with patient safety, GP workload and GP finances being affected.

Talks between the BMA, NHS England and PCSE began in a bid to raise these issues, to act quickly to resolve them and to give GPs and their practices confidence in the services PCSE provide. However, services are still falling short of what is acceptable.

3. HCA Home Visits – check your indemnity cover

If your HCA does an extended role that includes home visits for INR checks, diabetes checks and flu vaccinations your practice should check they are included in your indemnity cover. It has come to light recently that some Medical Defence Organisations do NOT include HCAs doing such roles within their corporate practice package. Other MDOs do provide cover under certain conditions. Check out the terms of your cover.

4. Check CCG data against practice data with regard to immunisation targets

Practices are advised to check data presented to them by CCGs with regard to levels of service provision, especially in relation to PMS/GMS premiums. In particular, CCG immunisation levels data should be checked against practices' own records.

Practices were advised to use the 6-in-1 vaccine when stocks of 5-in-1 were in short supply, but this substitution has not always been recognised when CCGs were compiling their data. It is important that practices flag any discrepancies between their own recorded data and CCG data in order to prevent underpayment.

The data CCGs use comes from Public Health England, who are modifying the search parameters used to gather it in order to capture the 6-in-1 use by practices. Once this is done we are expecting the data with CCGs to be retrospectively updated to reflect accurate figures.
