1. Strategic issues - what's going on

Delegated commissioning

Hillingdon practices voted for the CCG to take on delegated commissioning for primary care medical services from April. However, your LMC, working with your CCG, will continue to represent your interests as providers as before.

PMS Review

The pause on the PMS contract review has been lifted and the process has restarted. The CCG will lead the process and be consulting with the LMC. We will keep you informed of the latest developments as they occur.

2. Your LMC buddy – getting connected

4. Removing violent patients – do you know how?

NHS England have issued an update recently on the arrangements for the immediate removal of violent patients:- 'In the first instance, you should call Primary Care Support England (PCSE) on Telephone number 01772 221444 giving them the necessary details to initiate the removal. This should be followed up by completing the attached <u>form</u>, as soon as possible, and return it to pcse.immediateremovals@nhs.net. PCSE will then make all the necessary arrangements for the removal and allocation of the patient to the relevant violent patient care provider in your borough.'

5. Transfer of medical records – problems?

Some issues with Capita /PCSE have now been resolved but it is not clear whether the transfer of the medical records of new patients is now running smoothly. If you are still experiencing problems, please let the <u>LMC office</u> know, so we can gauge the extent of the issue and take it up with Capita.
